## IMPORTANT INFORMATION . . . PLEASE READ!

1. **PARKING:** Please park your car in the designated corral area.
2. **CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE JUDGING:**
  - a. Classes: Historic (1900 - 1980), Mid-Year (1981 - 2000), Contemporary (2001 - 2024).
  - b. Judging will be rated in the following categories: **Body and Finish; Trim, Wheels, and Exhaust; Interior and Trunk; and Engine Bay.** This will allow the entire field to be judged equally as the same team will judge the same areas of each car.
  - c. Unless rain is imminent or it is raining, convertible tops should be down, hoods and trunks open. A close underside inspection will not be made beyond visually checking wheels, tires and exhaust tips. Track dust and dirt will be ignored.
  - d. All items that normally remain in the car should stay in the car . . . there will be many spectators.
  - e. Please make sure you pick up a voting ballot for the popular vote. Please return People's Choice ballots to Registration by 1:00 p.m or by the end of the parade lap.
3. **AWARDS:** There will be an awards presentation at approximately 1:30 p.m. Awards include a first, second and third place for each class. Additional awards include Best in Show and Most Miles Driven to Mid-Ohio. Participants need to be present at the awards show in order to receive their award.
4. **REGISTRATION:** Please check in at the registration pop-up tent in the infield. You will receive a registration form for your car and a commemorative souvenir. Please fill out both parts of the registration form and turn in the bottom half at Registration. You will need to display the top half of the registration form on your **windshield** for judging. If you do not want your car to be judged, only display this during the parade lap. **Driver and all passengers in the car must sign the waiver form and be wearing the designated wristband to participate in the parade lap.**
5. **PARADE LAP:** All cars are eligible for a parade lap around the racetrack on Sunday. **Mandatory drivers' meeting held prior to lineup. Details will be posted at the registration tent.** Please follow the instructions of Mid-Ohio Staff. They will lead you and the other cars onto the racetrack. Safety is our number one priority. Please stay behind the pace car. Your speed will be monitored at all times. No passing will be permitted. The lap of the track will be dependent on weather and track conditions. Driver and all passengers must be wearing the designated wristband to participate.
